A Little Something From Pastor Jasmine

Greetings, Dear Church!

"Hail to the Lord's anointed..." I don't know if any of you are familiar with that hymn, but it takes on a different meaning in light of the Good Friday hail storm that we were blessed with. I wanted to take a moment to share an update on hail damage on the church and let you know where we're at.

As of the writing of this message, we're waiting for our insurance adjuster to come and do an assessment. As all of us were busy with dealing our own claims straightaway, and the church didn't have any urgent damage (no broken windows, etc), we got the ball rolling a little later in May. We took obvious damage on our roof and on the north side of our electric sign in the front yard. We're currently taking bids from contractors for a new roof and, per the manufacturer's warranty, we'll probably be getting our sign light board replaced. Stay tuned for more information throughout the summer.

Many people wonder, "how are we going to pay for a new roof? That's not in the budget this year!" You are correct, a new roof is not in the budget, but we have been planning for the eventual replacement of the roof for a while. Council will be working with the Trust Fund and the Finance team to determine the best way to

steward our finances for this undertaking, and we may be appealing to all of you to come up with some creative ways to help bolster such an expense later in the year. Stay tuned.

In the meantime, please give as you are able to the General Fund. We're 6 months into our budget, and giving has (as it always does in the summer) started to trend down. If you have made a personal offering goal or pledge to yourself this year, and you are able, please continue to honor it. Staying on budget for all of our regular expenditures is a faithful way that we can plan for our future and all these upcoming unbudgeted expenses.
