Church Roof Update

The church roof sustained damage in the April storm as most roofs in Platteville did. We are working with our insurance carrier Church Mutual for damage assessment and reimbursement. Our deductible was increased substantially last year, and so our cost of the repairs will be significantly higher than in the past. Eastman Cartwright has been selected as our contractor, and we hope to have repairs completed this fall. Cost estimates after insurance look to be around \$ 76,000. Council and the Trust Fund are working together to devise a payment plan. Please prayerfully consider a donation to this project above and beyond your regular giving. We appreciate your support.
